

Costs

The costs of treatment, residence, and board, may be covered in a variety of ways.

Insurance, Medicaid, local resources and client self-pay are commonly melded to provide for the 'wrap-around' service delivery. Room fees and board are kept low.

Most clients develop the means to provide for these, during the course of treatment. No one is turned away for lack of money: a sliding fee-scale applies to counseling and case management services; individualized payment plans are developed for each resident as needed.

Services

Services are provided by our licensed and certified staff.

Services include psychiatric services, licensed professional counseling, supervised therapists, alcohol and drug counseling, and case management.

On-call services are provided through Sitka Community Hospital

We refer clients for health and social services as needed.

Referrals

Referrals may be made by community service providers, health councils, probation officers, courts, high-and medium-intensity treatment programs, and others.
